## **12-Month Enrollment Trends**

- Since 2022-23, enrollment increased 1.9% (undergraduate increased 2.2%, graduate increased 0.3%).
- Between 2013-14 and 2023-24, enrollment decreased 9.6% (undergraduate decreased 10.7%, graduate decreased 3.7%).



Note. 12-month enrollment is the total, unduplicated headcount of students enrolled during the academic year.

## **Degrees/Awards Trends**

- Since 2022-23, awards increased 5.7% (undergraduate increased 6.2%, graduate increased 3.9%).
- Between 2013-14 and 2023-24, awards increased 8.2% (undergraduate increased 5.0%, graduate increased 20.0%).
